The Demilitarized Zone (DMZ), a place located between South and North Korea, gets its name from the agreement to keep the territory demilitarized at all times. The DMZ roughly follows the 38th parallel north, which has separated North and South Korea since the Korean War. Although the DMZ is situated in a relatively unknown country, it is a crucial place worldwide.

The demilitarized zone was established for peace between the two countries, but it also serves as a rare transition zone between terrestrial and oceanic ecosystems. As weapons and violence are prohibited, the area has become a sanctuary for endangered animals such as mountain goats, which typically inhabit rocky mountains, and fanged musk deer, which are usually found in ancient forests. Consequently, scientists have argued that the DMZ should be continuously protected, given its global significance.

Moreover, the DMZ is essential for the environment. Currently, various environmental issues exist, with global warming being one of the most familiar. To mitigate its effects, preserving nature is vital, as trees and plants in forests absorb carbon

The Trump Card: Former US President Sells NFT Playing Cards to Raise Funds for Criminal Defense

"Successful Failure" of SpaceX Starship Launch

The Space Exploration Technologies Corporation (SpaceX) is an American spacecraft corporation famous for Elon Musk. On April 20 (PDT), in Los Angeles, SpaceX launched its starship, but it blew up. However, SpaceX announced it was a successful test flight. Experts see it as a step for the development of the vehicle. It was the first time the starship and the SuperHeavy (booster rocket) took off from the ground. John Insprucker, a commenter on the webcast and engineer of SpaceX, said this failure would provide a lot of data for the next test. Starship is a fully two-stage reusable rocket with a total height of 120 m. The Super Heavy needed to separate after three minutes after the launch, and the starship had to start orbit flight according to the original plan. However, it could not be separated because of engine problems and exploded by its system.

There are 5 types of character cards, and each has special abilities which they can use. First is the Contessa. Contessa can block assassinations. Next is the assassin. The assassin can kill people using 3 coins as payment. The ambassador can switch cards on the deck and block the stealing of coins. The Captain can steal 2 coins from any other players except when the other players use the ambassador ability or the captain's other ability, which is to block stealing. The Duke looks like a Buddhist monk. He can take 3 coins from the deck which is called tax. He can also block foreign aid, the taking of 2 coins, which will be explained later.

There are 3 ways of getting coins. First is taking income, which cannot be blocked or challenged. Foreign aid is the taking of 2 coins, but it can be blocked. The main point of the game is that you can lie about your role, like pretending to be a duke but actually being a contessa. If feeling suspicious about a person, you can challenge players that they are not in their role. If you prove them false, they lose one card. If you are wrong you lose one card. Coup is fairly simple. It takes little time. It is also very strategic, and it makes players do critical thinking. If you are finding a game closer to being perfect, coup is it.





BOOK REVIEW: *Because of Winn-Dixie* by Kate DiCamillo


